

Dr. Alexis Grigorieff

Official teaching roles between 2014 and 2024



Overview:

Over the past ten years, I have been both a lecturer and a class teacher in economics and econometrics at several leading universities, such as the University of Oxford, the London School of Economics (LSE) and Sciences Po Paris. I have experience both at the graduate and undergraduate level, and I have taught a wide range of subjects in economics, ranging from behavioural economics to development economics. I always tailor my teaching to the students I have in front of me and I have a very good understanding of the issues that students can encounter when studying economics and how they can be solved. I have received overwhelmingly positive feedback on my lectures in econometrics for the MSc in Economic and Social History at the University of Oxford and on my lectures in quantitative methods for Sciences Po's School of International Affairs. Furthermore, I received several bonuses for outstanding teaching at LSE.

Since 2014, I have graded many exams, assignments, essays and I can provide valuable advice on the best practices to follow and the pitfalls to avoid. I also took part in the selection process of incoming undergraduate students at the University of Oxford (PPE, Economics and Management) and I can help prospective students prepare for Oxford and Cambridge interviews.

Summary of my teaching experience by subject:

1. **Econometrics:** I taught it for many years at LSE, Oxford, and Sciences Po at both undergraduate and graduate levels.
2. **Microeconomics:** I taught this subject at Oxford for several years as a lecturer.
3. **Development economics:** I taught this subject at Oxford to 3rd year undergraduates.
4. **Behavioural economics:** I wrote my PhD thesis on behavioural economics and I taught a summer course on that subject.
